

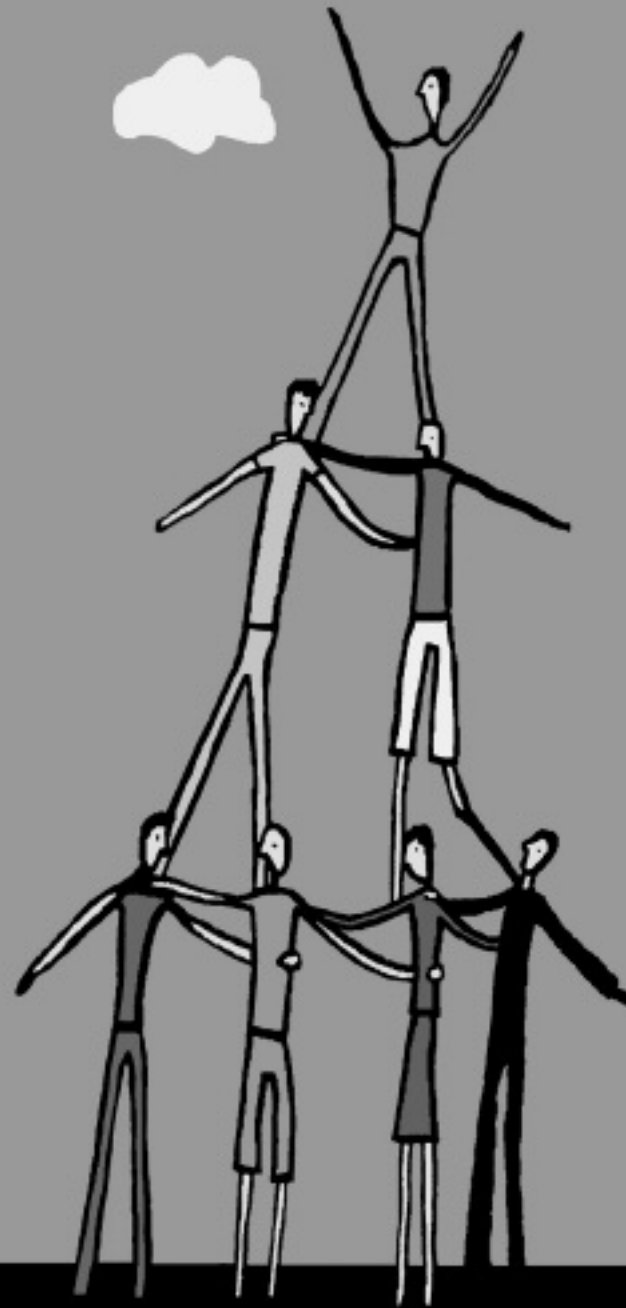

Established in 1987, Leadership Fairfax Inc. (LFI) is a nonprofit educational organization managed by people who are committed to the ideal of trusteeship and volunteerism. Our goal is to build a base of understanding about our community, educate and inform, and to ultimately engage individuals to become agents of positive change in Fairfax and the Northern Virginia region.

LFI's mission is to develop, connect and inspire leaders to strengthen our communities.

We conduct two annual educational programs to develop leaders and establish a network of graduates who will contribute to the welfare of Fairfax County and Northern Virginia. The programs include:

- **Leadership Fairfax Signature Program** consists of professionals that are already leaders in their organization. In this ten-month program, participants focus in-depth on a number of issues facing our community, such as economic development, land-use and transportation, education, youth and criminal justice.
- **Emerging Leaders Institute Program (ELI)**, established in 2002, is a nine-month curriculum that focuses on developing core leadership competencies, mentoring support and community service. ELI students consist of "rising stars" that are moving up in their organizations and have a desire to sharpen their skills and to learn ways to give back to their community.

Financial Report

Leadership Fairfax, Inc. (LFI) ended fiscal year 2006 with an increase in net assets of approximately \$96,000. The better than expected financial results were achieved principally from large class participation and successful events.

Total revenue for the year was approximately \$609,000, net of direct event cost. Revenue increased \$62,000 or 11% over the amount from 2005.

Revenue items that had the largest changes over prior year amounts are:

- Tuition revenue increased \$34,000 due to a one year increase in class size.
- Net events revenue increased \$32,000 due to a highly successful gala and golf tournament.

Total costs and expenses for 2006 were approximately \$513,000. Costs and expenses increased \$44,000 or 8.5% over 2005 amounts.

Expense items that had the largest changes over prior year amounts are:

- Printing and design costs increased \$7,000 due to the organization's investment in upgrading the LFI Web site.
- Professional fees increased \$5,000 due to the outsourcing of the organization's accounting department.
- Other expenses that have increased approximately \$2,000 over 2005 include: Funded scholarships, insurance, program meetings, rent, membership directory, meetings and seminars, and supplies.

Looking ahead to fiscal year 2006, LFI's management and board are optimistic about the organization's prospects for continued fiscal success. Class participants, members and contributors can expect LFI's management and board to be focused on effectively managing operations, evaluating program content and providing alumni access to area leaders through our innovative networking programs.
